 - Approved by the Board

- Police report: No APD representatives present/ no report

- Vice President's Report: Woody O
 - Woody had attended recent CABQ Mayor's Neighborhood Forum
 - Most of the ~250 neighborhood associations in ABQ & most CABQ offices were represented
 - Meeting format: panels, work groups, networking & "open forum"
 - The Rice Amendment, re: Southwest Airlines, is expiring
 - Expected to lead to estimated decrease in 15% of aircraft traffic at the Sunport
 - Code violations: currently require action in municipal or district court
 - So often not pursued
 - There is consideration of creating a CABQ office to address violations, to reduce the burden in the courts
 - Requires state legislative action

- Audit of 2012 GHNA Board expenditures: Dave P
 - Completed – Dave summarized findings
 - Moved/ seconded by Kris C/ Larry W to approve the 2012 audit
 - Audit report approved by the GHNA Board

 - APD staffing at Foothills Command is good
 - Dwyer substation is not staffed, or projected to be staffed
 - Presently being used by APD for ~ weekly classes
 - APD Ride-alongs may be considered for NA Board members, upon request
 - D8 website is now “up”
 - GH South has been renamed “Comanche Foothills”
 - Crime issues:
 - Adults are dropping off kids in neighborhoods; kids then break into homes
 - Dog doors may be home burglary entry points
 - Notes are attached to minutes
 - Hospitality/Welcome: Kris
 - Welcome baskets to 3 new GHN neighbors, and another was identified
 - She has acquired an Easter Bunny costume for the annual GHNA Easter Egg Hunt
 - Environment/Landscaping: Nick M. – absent, no report
